Our family commenced management of the hotel in 1996, shortly after becoming a member of the Italian cooperative Best Western, which facilitated the hotel's entry into international markets. In 2006, we initiated our first significant restructuring intervention, and since that time, we have consistently pursued a process of continuous improvement, both structurally and organizationally. In the diverse restyling activities, we focused on the selection of materials, prioritizing natural options such as iron and wood. We emphasized the procurement of recyclable furniture and engaged local consultants, companies, and artisans.


The majority of the courses are conducted as webinars, while others inherently necessitate inperson attendance.



#### **Corporate subsidies**

Upon achieving the company's predetermined qualitative and quantitative objectives, our employees will receive a welfare credit that can be utilized in the subsequent year for: fuel vouchers and/or shopping vouchers, public transport passes, educational and training opportunities for themselves and their families, wellness and personal care services, recreational activities, and supplementary pension contributions.







## **Distinct Collection and Oversight**


We maintain a stringent separate waste collection system and continuously monitor our consumption of water, electricity, gas, and the volume of waste generated. Separate waste collection bins are available in all common areas, individual rooms, and the meeting room. Additionally, we collect various other waste types separately and subsequently deliver them to the municipal eco-centre, including exhausted batteries, toners, metals, wood, WEEE, glass, inert materials, paints, and household appliances.

#### Decrease in consumption

We exclusively acquire electricity generated from renewable sources certified by RECS, and we also partially produce it ourselves through a photovoltaic system with a capacity of up to 17 kWh, which meets approximately 15% of our requirements.

We conduct an annual assessment of CO2 emissions to gauge our impact and identify areas for improvement. In the hotel, we utilize building automation software that enables us to regulate room temperature and electrical systems in each individual room according to guest occupancy or window status. Additionally, in all common areas and technical rooms, we can control and adjust relative temperatures, while nearly all lighting is managed by presence detectors or timers. All appliances utilized in the rooms, including minibars, hairdryers, kettles, and irons, are energy-efficient. Year after year, we have invested in enhancing the performance of our structure: the facades and roof have been treated with thermal coating; all fixtures possess high thermal and acoustic efficiency; 100% of the light bulbs are energy-efficient; and the appliances are designed for low energy consumption.


Attention to water consumption is consistently monitored. We have assessed the risk level of our region using the Aqueduct Water Risk Atlas website and have implemented conservation and awareness policies for our guests. Our faucets are designed for low consumption and equipped with flow reducers.




#### Sustainable transportation

We promote the utilization of public transportation. The parking area is equipped with charging stations for vehicles, and bicycles and e-bikes are available for our customers. These measures aim to minimize CO2 emissions to the greatest extent possible.







# **Acquisition Policies**

We implement meticulous and precise purchasing policies, prioritizing local suppliers and producers, organic products, FairTrade items, and, in all instances, certified products. This strategy minimizes the environmental impact of transportation and bolsters the local economy.

We are striving to minimize the use of single-serving products and are continually seeking new alternatives that are more environmentally friendly.

We encourage our suppliers to seek business partners that align with the policy we have implemented.

For instance, more than 90% of breakfast items are organic and may be sourced locally, designated as DoP, DoC, or FairTrade.





**Support for Community and Local Culture** 

We assert that "culture is the essence of tourism," and consequently, we endorse local organizations that cultivate and disseminate cultural initiatives.

We present exclusive exhibitions, where visitors can immerse themselves in the art and culture of Pordenone through projects focused on cinema and poetry.

In the breakfast room, there exists a library participating in a book-crossing initiative, enabling our guests to unwind by selecting an engaging read.

The meeting room features a permanent exhibition titled "Guest," a collection of photographic portraits by photographer Valentina laccarino.

On the fourth floor, one embarks on a journey through early cinema, featuring posters for each edition of the international festival Le Giornate del Cinema Muto.

We also partner with associations, businesses, and local authorities to enhance their initiatives in the social, health, community, and sports sectors.
